



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
MEETING ON CLUP 01/24/2006**

A meeting was held with Sheldon Johnson from Northwest Regional Planning Commission. Town residents attending were Town Chairman Krause, Charlie Baumann, George Miller and Clerk Guyer.

Sheldon recommended some amendments that should be made to the Comprehensive Land Use Plan. He stated that the Plan does not have to be approved by the State of Wisconsin, it needed to be approved by the residents of the Town of Spider Lake which it was in April 2002.

The Plan should be updated at least every five years. Amendments made to the Plan would be sent to the Town Planning and Review Commission and they would recommend back to the Town Board for final approval. After the Town Board approves, a Public Hearing would be advertised 30 days prior to the set date.

Mr. Johnson will send some of his recommendations on the Plan revision in about two weeks.
