



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 2008 02/05/2008**

Miller called the meeting to order at 9:00am on Tuesday, February 5, 2008, noting that a number of members had notified him that they would not attend, including Charlie Baumann, Dick Thearin, Mary Witt, John Kuntz, and Bob Schroeder. Present were Keith Larson, Mike McGuiness, Carol Alcoe, George Miller, Butch Meyer, Kathy Overman, Gene Krause and Jim Imse. Though automotive maladies kept Kuntz away, he wanted to be included in any composing of a Shoreland Management Guide. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as amended, and are now posted on the Town website.

The group continued work on the outline, from page 9-3 of the Draft Amended Plan of 9-28-07.

page 9-3, F.5, add "that includes habitat and water quality considerations."

Ross here offered the concept of allowing clustered housing on forestry acres being converted to residential use, something presently precluded by zoning regulations. This topic, and "municipal boat moorings" will be discussed by Ross and Krause at the next meeting.

page 9-4, G, change to "Encourage protection and preservation of wildlife habitat through education"

G.1, delete

B.1, change "Develop" to "Maintain"

B.5, add a first word, "Support"

B.6, delete, and make B.7 become B.6, inserting the word "special" before the word "township."

C.4, change "municipality" to municipally"

D.1, add the words "If necessary" to start the sentence.

D.3, move to page 9-2 as I.B.5.b

page 9-5, F.1, change "Allow" to "Encourage."

G.1, delete

Miller asked all to prepare for the next meeting by working on pages 9-21 to 9-29 and the following map. The next meeting will also include a discussion of how to invite a wider input into revision and rewriting of the Comprehensive Plan. The hearing for the revised Plan is expected to be in mid-June. At this next meeting a questionnaire will be composed for the newsletter and website so that all town land-owners can prepare for the hearing.

So the homework is in three parts:

1. review pages 9-21 to 9-29
2. review the entire document (9-29-07 Draft) and
3. Bring suggestions for the questionnaire.
