



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 2008 - 02/18/2008**

The meeting of the Comprehensive Plan 2008 Committee was called to order by Miller at 9:00am on Monday, February 18, 2008 in the Spider Lake Town Hall. Present were George Miller, Mike McGuiness, Charlie Baumann, Carol Alcoe, Mary Witt, Butch Meyer, Keith Larson, Bob Schroeder and Prue Ross. Jim Imse was late.

Continuing the process of correcting the 9-28-07 Draft Comp Plan, it was noted that throughout the draft there was a sloppiness about capitalizing the word "town." Wherever that word refers specifically to the Town of Spider Lake, or any other municipality, it should be capitalized. For instance, on page 9-21, third last line, it should be "Town."

page 9-22, just below the center of the page, the entire sentence that begins "Maintains rural and open landscape..." is deleted

page 9-22, "Recommendations Achieved" should read "Recommendations Achieved through 2007"

-in the last bullet on the page, "plant sale is" should read "plant sale was."

-among the "Recom. Ach. " two more bullets should be added to read, "The Town Plan & Review Commission was restaffed to include other citizens beside Town Board members. " and "Mitigation has become a major consideration in resolving property management issues."

page 9-23, the very last bullet, "The Town works closely..." is deleted.

-the fifth bullet down, "Coordinate ATV..." is rewritten to say, "Cooperated with adjacent Townships and the Forest Service on ATV and snowmobile route development."

page 9-24, near the center of the page, the bullet stating "Establish an incentive..." is rewritten to say, "Encourage Sawyer County incentive program for development of shoreland buffer zone."

-the last bullet at the bottom of the page, "Promote low-density..." is changed to read, "Use cluster or conservation subdivision provisions where they will maintain or promote northwoods character. "

page 9-26, second last line on the page, change "zoning committee, to "Plan & Review Commission."

page 9-27, fourth paragraph down, second line, change "reflects and includes" to "is not incompatible with."

page 9-28, second and third paragraphs, "Preservation" and "Large lot," why are these included, what does the technical vocabulary mean? Ask NRPC why this is included.

page 9-29, third bullet, change "Authorize a" to "Continue the"

-last bullet, change first word "Acknowledge" to "Monitor."

-add one bullet, to read, "Town Board should provide opportunity for all land owners to obtain a copy of the Plan."

page 9-4, after the letter H. 1-3, add the letter "I" as follows:

I. Research the effects on the aquifers of high-density housing

page 9-19, add after H. 3: "I. Research the effects on the aquifers of high density housing."

"1. the objective is to protect and preserve the quantity and quality of the aquifers."

map 9-1, the zoning map underlying the circled categories is outdated – a current zoning map must be used.

The committee members agreed that no questionnaire is needed for the participants of the public hearing.

The next meeting will be scheduled once Northwest Regional Planning Commission returns a corrected Draft Plan. The meeting was adjourned at 11:30.
