



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE
PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING 3-12-2004**

The Town of Spider Lake Planning Committee meeting was called to order on 3-12-2004 at 6:30 P.M. by Committee Chairman Promersberger. Present was Promersberger, G. Brandt, Overman, Krause, Zoning Administrator Boss and Clerk Guyer. Absent was King. Also present was Prudence Ross, Attorney Mike Kelsey and Carol Alcoe.

Boss presented an application for 15 units and a letter authorizing him to change the application to 16 units. The letter was read by Promersberger and made part of the minutes. The Board stated that the existing cabins on the preliminary plat of Teal Lake Shores are non-conforming. Krause stated that the roads must be brought up to state specifications per SS 236.29, Dedication under Platting land and per Wis. SS #86.26, Town road standards if the Town is to take over maintenance of the roads. The Board also requested that two cul-de-sacs be put in for access for emergency equipment. Ross to have the surveyor certify that all lots have proper footage to meet all setbacks. All cabins existing need to meet all setbacks as well as all the resort cabins. Plat needs to show all roads within the plat.

Clerk to send all information to the Town Attorney on questions the Board has and check for the amount of proper fee for a Public Hearing.

Motion to adjourn was made by G. Brandt, seconded by Overman. All in favor, motion carried.
