



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONTHLY BOARD MEETING 3/14/2007**

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Spider Lake Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Krause. Present was Krause, Overman, Brandt, Imse, Promersberger, Zoning Administrator Boss, Clerk Guyer and Treasurer J. Brandt.

The minutes of the P&RC and Town Board Meeting held February 14, 2007 were reviewed by the Board. Motion to approve was made by Promersberger, seconded by Imse. All in favor, motion carried.

The Treasurers report was given with a balance on hand 2/28/07 of \$288,449.51. New reports were given to the Board with the ten cent error corrected. COL for the Fire Dept. is \$18,906.50, Holding Tanks \$4400. Loans and Delinquent Personal property tax remain the same. Motion to approve the Treasurers report was made by Promersberger, seconded by Overman. All in favor, motion carried.

Payroll vouchers # 15530-15544 in the amount of \$7,070.66 were presented for payment. Motion to approve was made by Overman, seconded by Promersberger, all in favor, motion carried.

General Vouchers # 15545-15566 in the amount of \$20,505.22 were presented for payment. Motion to approve was made by Imse, seconded by Promersberger, all in favor, motion carried.

NWRPC suggestion for something for the Township was shelters at boat landings.

There will be a Fire Protection Dist. Meeting on March 19th at the LCO Convention Center to discuss how Chippewa Falls Fire Protection works and was formed and share ideas.

Brandt presented the Updated Recycling Resolution. Motion to approve was made by Overman, seconded by Promersberger. All in favor, motion carried.

Imse explained he was given a copy of an Ordinance prohibiting Nude Dancing and asked if that is something the Town should be considering. The Board will set up an Ad hoc committee to look into it. Imse also stated that the Insurance renewal will be this year, bids will be solicited.

Krause reported that he has a bid for a new computer for the Road Department in the amount of \$1918. Overman to check to see if DSL can be hooked up at the Town Garage from the Town Hall. Road bans were put on 3/12/07. Septic trucks are allowed with 1/2 loads in early AM only. The Road Crew is steaming culverts. LLRIP projects are being held up pending the State budget.

Overman reported on two bridges in Round Lake that are posted for heavy equipment to "speed of crawl", that is on the Tiger Cat on Twin Lake Road.

Promersberger reported that the Fire Dept. Assets are \$17,610.85. They are purchasing another defibrillator for Shannon Nelson. Health & Safety Committee meeting should be held for work on the Ordinance for Driveways. Meeting will be held 3/27/07 at 6:30 PM at the Town Hall. There will also be training on wild land fires. The Fire Dept. radios cannot be used with the new program so the radios will have to be replaced. The Mutual Aid Renewal has been completed. Some Towns are having their Town Attorney reviewing them.

Lee Nelson has completed his Fire Inspection training. Motion to approve hiring him at the rate of \$10.00 per hour and him using the Town brush truck for inspections was made by Overman, seconded by Imse. All in favor, motion carried.

There was a meeting of interested Town Personal on ATV's held Feb. 28th. Representatives from Spider Lake, Nabagagon, Cable, Drummond, Grand View, Moose Lake and Round Lake were present. There is no plan for a trail that goes anywhere. The Alliance has a trail plan. More meetings will be held.

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Overman reported that the P&RC recommends to the Town Board to approve the CSM for Whiplash Land Co. LLC, located in SW 1/4 - NE 1/4, Sec 30-T42N-R6W, also being all of Lot 1 CSM #7388. 200 foot of road frontage to be put on each parcel and it was done. Motion to approve was made by Krause, seconded by Promersberger. All in favor, Motion carried. Property with a 10,000 foot grading violation was referred back to the DNR for determination of the OHWM.

Brandt reported there was a free pickup of white goods for the month of March which the Town didn't do. He stated the Fire Department Surplus was \$6913.85. He would like \$6900. be added to the Fire Dept. COL fund. He also stated the Fire Dept. assests reported included the \$5,000. paid to the Town so the actual assests for the Fire department is \$12,610.85.

The Clerk reported that the Drug and Alcohol testing of Town employees will be noticed to the town each quarter of the year. Wirth removed his land that he was not compliant on from MFL. A check in the amount of \$5,000. has been received from Bay Logging with his agreement. The Town will have three election workers on the April 3, 2007 election.

Motion to adjourn was made by Brandt, seconded by Overman. All in favor, motion carried.
