



TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING 4-8-2003

The Town of Spider Lake Annual Town meeting was called to order on April 8, 2003 by Town Chairman, Krause. Elected officials present, Chairman Krause, Supervisors Promersberger, Overman, Brandt and King. Also present was Treasurer Janet Brandt and Zoning Administrator Steve Boss. 13 electors were present in the audience. Absent was Clerk Guyer.

The minutes of the Annual Town Meeting held 4/9/02 were reviewed and Chairman Krause asked for a motion to approve. Charlie Bauman motioned to approve, motion 2nd by Richard Thearin, motion carried.

Chairman Krause stated that the roads to be asphalted this year will be, Dicksy, Mathey, Lugner and Nelson.

Mary Witt asked if it would be possible for the Town to take tires for disposal from road clean up. George Brandt stated that the tires would be taken in and held until the next white goods pick up.

The Financial report for 2002 was reviewed and discussed. George Miller stated he'd like to see some funds made available for educating the Town's people on the Comprehensive Land Use Plan, such as mailings, newsletters, etc. Chairman Krause stated that the funds now in the contingency fund could be used for that.

Mary Witt reported that the Native Plant sale pick up is set for 6/21/03 for pre-paid orders.

Chairman Krause asked for a motion to approve the Financial report, motion was made by Mike Anderson, 2nd by Carol Alcoe, motion carried.

Mike Anderson motioned that \$500.00 be donated to the Hayward Sports Center, 2nd by George Brandt, all approved, motion carried.

Charlie Bauman motioned to donate \$1000.00 to the Library Building fund, 2nd by Carol Alcoe, all approved, motion carried.

Gene Krause motioned to donate \$500.00 to the Spider Lake Cemetery, Delores Brandt 2nd all approved, motion carried.

Mike Anderson reported on the activities of the County Parks and Recreation committee.

Concerns about the Town's zoning restrictions on lake properties and resorts were expressed by Richard & Romona Thearin and Prudence Ross. Chairman Krause stated that another meeting will be scheduled regarding these new proposals as they relate to Resorts and Condos, and all interested town residents will have the opportunity to attend and voice those concerns.

Carol Alcoe questioned when best to contact the Assessor. Delores Brandt stated that the Assessor has missed two appointments she had scheduled with him.

Carol Alcoe questioned when the rustic roads sign & the black and white directional sign will be posted. Chairman Krause reported that they have not been able to put in new posts with the ground frozen but it would be completed by the Native Plant Sale pick up date.

Mr. Hogue stated that he continues to be harassed by snowmobiles and ATVs and that the Town Board has the power to close Christy Lake if they wanted to.

Charlie Bauman motioned to adjourn, Mike Anderson 2nd all approved, motion carried.
