



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
ANNUAL TOWN MEETING 04/08/2008**

The Town of Spider Lake Annual Town meeting was called to order by Chairman Krause. Elected officials present were Krause, Imse, Brandt, Promersberger, McGuiness, Treasurer Overman and Clerk Guyer. Also in attendance was Zoning Administrator Steve Boss. There were 14 electors present.

The Clerk read the minutes from the Annual Town Meeting held 4/10/2007. Motion to approve was made by Brian Hucker, seconded by James Imse. All in favor, motion carried.

The Chairman reviewed the 2007 budget report.

Donations were considered. James Imse asked if all requests/causes could be listed before any motions be made.

A Motion was made by Charles Bauman to donate \$1,000.00 to the Library, seconded by Schroeder, all in favor motion carried. Imse questioned giving that much to the Library without considering what the other requests may need. Those that were in favor were asked to signify again. All in favor except Imse. The motion stands. Ross moved that 50% of the donation be specified for Large Print. After discussion and a show of hands the majority were in favor of donating it to the General Fund, Ross withdrew her motion.

Janet Brandt moved to donate \$500.00 for the painting to National Fresh Water Fishing Hall of Fame. Motion seconded by Promersberger, all in favor except Alcoe. Motion carried.

Brandt moved to donate \$500.00 to the Sports Center, seconded by Thearin, all in favor, motion carried.

Janet Brandt moved to donate \$500.00 to the Spider Lake Cemetery Fund. Motion seconded by Dolores Brandt. All in favor, motion carried.

Krause stated that the LRIP Grant will be used for Murphy Blvd. starting at Balsam Road to the bridge. Other roads considered for seal coating and other work will be Paddock, three miles on Upper A and Pederson. Road inspection will be done after the weather warms up.

Paddock Road was discussed where a new culvert was put in and will be looked at in the road Inspection along with other areas. Mary Witt said "Good Job" on the Roads again this past year.

Witt questioned the possibility of a Safety Officer to address educational for Safety violations only. Krause state nothing to be done now, but maybe down the road. It will be up to the courtesy patrol to let people know they are violating the law.

Dolores Brandt stated the Chicken BBQ will be held July 6th and anyone wanting a poster to put up should contact the Fire Department. The Namakagon String Band will play from 12-6:00 P.M.

Motion to adjourn was made by Janet Brandt, seconded by McGuiness. All in favor, motion carried.
