



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI  
ANNUAL TOWN MEETING 04/10/2007**

The Town of Spider Lake Annual Town Meeting was called to order by Chairman Krause. Elected officials present were Chairman Krause, Supervisors Brandt, Promersberger, Imse and Overman and Clerk Guyer. Also present were Fire Chief D. Brandt and Zoning Administrator Boss.

The Minutes of the Annual Town Meeting held April 11, 2006 were read by the Clerk. Motion to approve was made by D. Brandt, seconded by McGuiness. Motion carried

The Annual Report was reviewed. Topp questioned the budgeted disbursement for Ord. Enforcement and Lake Monitoring. John Kuntz explained the Lake Grant. The \$10,000. budgeted for disbursement is also budgeted as a receipt as it would be a wash account. This grant is for the purpose of funding people willing to work at the boat landings checking for invasive species.

Alcoe stated the road crew did a good job on the roads this winter. Guyer stated she had gotten a letter from Witt's also stating a good job had been done.

The condition of County A and "OO" was discussed. Krause stated he thought that a section of County A would be redone.

Nathan Knochke of Ghost Lake Lodge presented a petition for Ghost Lake titled "Proposal to make Ghost Lake a "Quiet Lake" (10mph) and reads: As property owners on Ghost Lake we would like to petition the Town of Spider Lake to enact a 10mph speed limit at all times on Ghost Lake. This will be brought up at the regular monthly Town Board Meeting on April 11, 2007 under new business.

Ross moved to authorize the Town Board to bring up Lake Enforcement again sometime before the next Annual Meeting. A vote of the Electors was 14 in favor, 10 against. Motion passed

Knochke stated Sheer's road is in bad shape. Krause stated the committee will look at it. He stated the Town would probably not be doing any asphaltting this year but crack sealing may be done.

Topp questioned if there were any projects within the town, discussion was held and the idea of tables or benches for the boat landings was brought up.

D. Brandt stated the Fire Department needs lots of people. The Fire Department needs new radios. The Town has received the new Tender. She also discussed the mutual aid with Round Lake and the possibility they may merge in the future. This Summers Chicken BBQ will be held July 8th.

A Motion was made by Charlie Baumann to donate \$1000.00 to the Library, seconded by Alcoe. Motion carried.

Victoria Ross moved that the \$2,000.00 budgeted for donations be split with \$500. for the Sports Center, \$500 for the Spider Lake Cemetery and \$500. for the Library leaving \$500. set aside until November to see if the Fire Department needed it for radios. There was no second to the motion.

Ross then moved that \$500.00 be set aside for assisting the Fire Department for radios or go back into the budget for next year. Motion seconded by Topp. Motion passed

Bob Schroeder moved to donate \$500.00 to the Cemetery, seconded by Topp. Motion carried.

Ross moved to reconsider the motion to donate \$1000.00 to the Library, seconded by Woods, Motion failed.

Motion to adjourn was made by Topp, seconded by McCracken. Motion passed.
