



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
ANNUAL TOWN MEETING 4/11/2006**

The Annual Town meeting for the Town of Spider Lake was called to order on April 11, 2006 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall. Elected officials present were Krause, G. Brandt, Overman, King, Promersberger, Treasurer J. Brandt, and Clerk Guyer. There were 23 electors present.

The minutes of the Annual Meeting held 4-12-05 were read. Motion to approve was made by McGuinness and seconded by Imse. All in favor, motion carried.

Imse moved to donate \$1,000.00 to the Hayward Carnegie Library and \$500.00 each to the Hayward Sports Center and the Spider Lake Cemetery. Motion seconded by Ross. All in favor, motion carried.

Ross moved that the donation to the Library go to the general fund and not the building fund, motion seconded by Thearin. All in favor, motion carried.

Brandt stated there would be a Town Clean Up running from May 27th to Sept. 3rd. Also the new recycling information will be mailed out with the Whispers newsletter.

Haag stated the road crew did a good job this winter. He stated the Road sign at the east end of Dick-Sy Rd was missing and also on the east end the 4X4 post that hold up the No ATV sign on Dick-Sy Rd is down. Krause to check with the Alliance regarding the no ATV sign.

Woods questioned if the Town could donate to the Lake associations for use of weed control etc. Clerk to check with Towns Association to see if it's legal.

The Clerk explained that at the November Election the Town would have a voting machine but paper ballots would also be available. Elections will cost considerably more from now on because of the cost of the voting machine plus the programming, updating etc. Shifts of Election workers will be used for future elections as the polls will open from 7 AM until 8:00 PM.

Clerk to check to see if the Town Hall property could be used for a drop site for the food shelf on Election Day.

Dolores Brandt stated the Fire Department got two grants totaling about \$35,000.00 which only cost the town \$712.00. The Annual Fire Department Chicken BBQ will be held July 9, 2006.

Krause stated the Town will receive a grant of approximately \$50,000. for road work. The Committee will be meeting soon to determine the road to be worked on and advertise for bids.

The Assessor has said that the revaluation would be completed and the tentative time for the Board of Review will be near the last week of September.

It was asked if the Town can leave snow on the sides of the roads for snowmobiles. Krause said the road committee will discuss it.

The Forest Service ATV signs were discussed. The Committee will meet with them again now that the snow is gone so see if more signs can be taken down.

Motion to adjourn was made by Stolfa, seconded by Thearin. All in favor, motion carried.
