



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
ANNUAL TOWN MEETING • APRIL 14, 2009**

The Town of Spider Lake Annual Town meeting of the Electors was called to order by outgoing Chairman Gene Krause. Fourteen electors plus 7 elected officials were present.

The minutes of the Annual Town Meeting held 4/8/2008 were reviewed. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Jim Imse, seconded by Brian Hucker. All in favor, motion carried.

The Budget summary for 2008 and the budget for 2009 was read by Krause. Total disbursements budgeted for 2008 was \$686,242.00, actual disbursements \$624,454.70 and budgeted for 2009 \$631,818.00. Total receipts budgeted for 2008 was \$397,526.84; actual receipts were \$435,346.39 and budgeted for 2009 is \$337,331.00. The Levy for 2008, payable in 2009 was \$233,578.00. Debt service as of 12/31/08 was \$124,392.47.

The Board budgeted \$1500.00 for donations. A motion was made by Imse to donate \$500. each to the Library, Spider Lake Cemetery and Hayward Sports Center. Motion seconded by Stimpson. After discussion, Imse amended his motion to change the \$500. donation approved for the Sports Center to be given to the Hayward Food Shelf instead. Stimpson seconded the amended motion. Motion carried.

Sharron Reynolds asked if there could be some signs placed on Pederson Road where the school bus needs to stop near the curves to pickup and drop off school children. Road Supervisor McGuinness will check that out.

The Town Hall carpeting was discussed. It was stated that nothing is going to be done now.

The Board was asked if we could have a collection for florescent bulbs. Solid Waste Supervisor Brandt will look into that.

Schroeder asked if there was a shortage of sand & salt this year. Roads were very icy in places. The Board explained that Sand and Salt does not work on ice if it is cold and with the winds we had this year, much sand and salt was blown off when trucks traveled on it.

Dolores Brandt stated the Spider Lake Volunteer Fire Department Annual Chicken BBQ will be held July 12th this year. The band will be "Take Three".

The newly elected Town officers had signed their oaths and were officially sworn in.

Motion to adjourn the Annual Town Meeting was made by Victoria Ross, seconded by Jim Imse.
