



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING 4-21-2005**

The Special Town Board Meeting was called to order on April 21, 2005 by Chairman Krause. Present was Krause, Promersberger King and Clerk Guyer. Absent were Overman and Brandt.

Purpose of the meeting was to open bids for the Road Work advertised for.

The first bid was from Sawyer County Highway in the amount of \$234,418.05 which was for Upper A 3.03 miles, Pulverizing \$13,635.00 and Paving \$120,600.00. Boys Cap Road 1.06 miles, Pulverizing \$4,770.00 and Paving \$42,571.80. Allan Road 1.19 miles Pulverizing 1.19 miles \$5,355.00 and Paving \$47,486.25.

The Second bid was from Monarch Paving Company. For Allan road it would be \$48,740.57, Boy's Camp Road \$43,844.96 and Upper A \$124,422.39, figures based on approximately 7,048 tons @ R30.79 per ton. Pulverizing would be \$17,410.50 for a total of \$234,418.42, figures based on approximately 5.3 miles @ \$3285.00 per mile.

The Bids were compared using per lineal foot which when figured was Monarch \$8.38 L.F and Sawyer County \$8.41 L.F.

Promersberger moved to accept the bid from Monarch. Road Committee to make the final decision on how much road work will be done based on the budget. Motion seconded by King. All in favor, motion carried.

Monarch stated that if the Town did less road work, the price per mile would remain the same.

Road Committee to meet on Wednesday 4-27-05 at 6:30 to make the decision on the amount of road work to be done.

Motion to adjourn was made by Promersberger, seconded by King. All in favor, motion carried.
