



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
ATV COMMITTEE MEETING 6/7/2006**

To: The Spider Lake Town Board of Supervisors

The ATV Committee met June 8 at 6:00pm. Present were Krause, Promersberger, Larson, Meyer, and Hogue.

Meetings and correspondence with the Forest Service resulted in only two ATV signs leading to private property being removed. Their position is the balance of the "trails" signed will need to go through their NEPA study. We then met with Don Mrotek (Sawyer County Trail Coordinator) and Nick Olson (Sawyer County Recreational Officer). Don has been working to get a route from Lakewoods to Clam Lake. Part of this trail would need to come through a northern section of Spider Lake Township. Many alternatives have been reviewed. A route that has the least road impact and rider confusion has been proposed. It would start at the junction of the snowmobile trail with FR203 to FR328, then north on FR204. This proposal would be for a 1 year contingency. All other Township roads will remain closed to ATVs and will be signed where deemed necessary. Opening a connecting route in the Forest will be criteria to negotiate elimination of the ATV signs on trails that do not go anywhere.

The committee will need to meet with concerned parties from Namekagon, and Don Mrotek to interface with their proposed route to connect to the roads we have agreed to open. Then we can move forward with a proposal for an ordinance change. To obtain a positive and productive meeting, we would like the request for this meeting to come from the Town Board.
