



TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING 8-13-2003

The regular Town of Spider Lake Board of Supervisors meeting was called to order by Chairman Krause on 8/13/2003. Present was Krause, King, G. Brandt, Overman, Treas. J. Brandt, Clerk Guyer and Zoning Administrator Boss. Absent was Promersberger.

Krause recommended to the Town Board that the recommendation of the Town of Spider Lake Planning Committee Meeting of 7/24/2003 to change the Zoning for Richard and Romoma Thearin from RR-1 to RR-2 with the third cabin being next to Mr. Yagle be occupied by a non rental customer which would be supervising the property be approved. Motion to approve was made by Brandt, seconded by Overman. All in favor, Motion Carried.

A motion was made by King and seconded by Brandt that the minutes of July 9, 14, 17 and 7/24/2003 be approved with the word corrections being made. All in favor, Motion Carried.

The Treasurers report was given and made part of the minutes. Balance on Hand 7/31/2003 \$432,608.95. Loans, Capitol Outlay and holding tanks remain the same. Delinquent Personal Property Tax for Ross Teal Lake Resort in the amount of \$1,019.41 plus interest and penalty and Teal Wing Golf Course in the amount of \$9,560.26 plus interest and penalty and still outstanding. Motion to approve the Treasurers report was made by Overman, seconded by King. All in favor, Motion Carried.

Boss has an application for an addition with reduced building setback. He stated the addition should be on the farthest side from the lake. Krause stated the intent of the Zoning Ordinance was to add anywhere as long as it is 56' from the high water mark. Town Board to recommend to the Planning Committee to clarify that portion of the Ordinance.

Boss to issue a citation to Thearin for starting construction without a building permit.

Motion to approve amending the fee schedule to double fees if a building is started before a permit is issued was made by Brandt, seconded by King. All in favor, Motion Carried.

Payroll vouchers #13256-13261 in the amount of \$3,314.91 Was presented for payment.. Motion to approve was made by Overman, seconded by Brandt. All in favor, Motion Carried.

General Vouchers #13262-13282 in the amount of \$12,125.37 was presented for payment. Clerk to hold the check for A. Fuller #13262 to find out what the charge is for. Motion to approve all of the rest of the checks plus a check for Sawyer County for Property Tax Credit in the amount of \$193,964.39 was made by Overman, seconded by King. All in favor, Motion Carried.

Motion to approve the bid for Paul Thompson in the amount of \$11,610.00 for hauling gravel was made by Brandt, seconded by King. All in favor, Motion Carried.

Brandt stated that they picked up the roll off box at the Solid Waste center. They have different recycling bins now, Bauman stated he was concerned that garbage will be put in the recycling containers. Prudence Ross suggested clear bags for recycling.

Krause stated Mathey Road is graveled and they are not sure how much to asphalt yet. Nelson Road is being graveled and they will be pulverizing Dick-Sy and Nelson roads next week. Asphalt will be done in the next couple weeks. Bob Schroeder donated time and bolts for the Town Hall sign. Board to send a Thank you to Him!!

Overman reported that the Fire Dept. Picnic grossed \$9,000.35 with expenses of \$2,463.63 with a profit of \$6,536.72. They now have a savings balance of \$10,594.49 and checking account balance of \$1,388.63.

Overman stated that she is checking on improving water at the Town Hall and she is getting quotes for walls inside the garage.

The Clerk stated that she has a Picnic License for the Spider Lake Chair Assn. for Beer and wine for their Labor Day picnic providing they get a nonprofit status and it's legal. Motion was made by Brandt to approve the License after the Clerk checks it out. Seconded by Overman. All in Favor, Motion Carried.

Prudence Ross asked for a Road Sign for their Road. The one they have is in very bad shape.

Many people were in attendance regarding the water skiing on Lower Clam Lake. The hours now are from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM. They feel the Lake is too small and that it is being abused. Town to furnish names and addresses of people on Lower Clam Lake for them to write to and see what the majority of the people want.

Letters were read into the minutes that were written against the Ross Condo Applications. Copies of the letters were given to Mrs. Ross.

The Chairman read a letter from a property owner on Mathey Road that does not want asphaltting.

The Clerk reported on the letter from Como Propane regarding the gas incentives for this year. Overman stated she and Promersberger would like to attend the Wisconsin Towns State Convention in October. Clerk to put on September agenda.

Prudence Ross asked if she could get a list of all property owners on Teal and Lost Land Lake.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Overman, seconded by King. All in Favor, Motion Carried.
