



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING 8/14/2007**

The Special Town Board Meeting was called to order on 8/14/2007 by Chairman Krause. Present were Krause, Imse, Promersberger, McGuinness, Brandt, and Clerk Guyer.

Purpose of the meeting was to consider an appointment for Town Chairman and work on a Condition Report for the Town Boating Ordinance proposed Amendment Hearing to be held August 20, 2007.

The Chairman explained that the Wis. Towns Association was contacted and they gave advice on where he can claim residency until his intent to not return to the Township is determined. At this point, he is not going to resign as his intent right now may be to return to the Town. He stated he has agreed to work on the Sawyer County CLUP. George Miller will be contacted to see if he would be interested in being an alternate if Krause should resign in the future.

The Condition Report for the DNR that must be done for the proposed Boating Ordinance Amendment brought considerable discussion. Krause stated he recommends the Town write the Condition report out of the conditions stated at the Public Hearing. Motion to accept this recommendation was made by Imse, 2nd by McGuinness. All in favor, motion carried. Clerk to fax Condition report information to Nathan Knoche and ask if all the people around Ghost Lake have been contacted. Clerk to also contact the DNR to clarify who should write the Condition Report.

Motion to adjourn was made by Brandt, 2nd by McGuinness. All in favor, motion carried.
