



TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
PUBLIC HEARING ON BOATING ORDINANCE #12 AMENDMENT 8-20-2007

The Town of Spider Lake Public Hearing on Boating Ordinance #12 Amendment was called to order on Aug. 20, 2007 by Chairman Krause. Present was Krause, Imse, Promersberger, McGuiness, Brandt and Clerk Guyer. Eight people were in attendance.

Nathan Knoche explained why he thought the Ordinance should be Amended to eliminate Ghost Lake from the 11-3 PM water skiing on the Ordinance. He stated the Lake is dangerous and presented a Condition Report stating the 6 or more hazards on the lake when the water level is the highest and more than 14 when the water level is down. He also stated that Ghost Lake has been advertised and known as one of the "Quiet Lakes" for many years. (A copy of the Condition Report is on file at the Clerks office)

An email from Sue Gorski was read stating that a Condition Report must state facts, not opinions. Bauman explained that the Lake Association is the ones that decided to call Teal, Lost Land and Ghost Lake the "Quiet Lakes". He read portions of the Court Report where the 10 mph on Teal and Lost Land was upheld in Court.

Much discussion followed.

A motion was made by McGuiness to leave the Ordinance the way it is at this time, seconded by Promersberger. Krause, Promersberger and McGuiness voted in favor, Imse and Brandt voted against. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by McGuiness, seconded by Brandt. All in favor, motion carried.
