



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONTHLY BOARD MEETING 10/11/2006**

The regular monthly Town Board Meeting for the Town of Spider Lake was called to order on October 11, 2006 by Chairman Krause. Present was Krause, Imse, Promersberger, Overman, Brandt, Treasurer J. Brandt, Zoning Administrator Boss and Clerk Guyer.

The minutes of the P&RC and TBM held 9-13-2006 and 10-5-2006 was reviewed by the Board. Motion to approve was made by Overman, seconded by Promersberger. All in favor, Motion carried.

John Kuntz introduced Kristene Macky who talked regarding the nine lakes in Sawyer County that has Milfoil. The Spider Lake Association stated they would like to be proactive with education and prevention. There are grants available but the Town must submit the grant application. Cable Town did this and they are willing to meet with our Town regarding the process. The Town would issue the checks and cover the liability. The Health and Safety Committee to meet and discuss this.

The Treasurers report was given and made part of the minutes. Balance on Hand 9/30/06 \$63,287.98. Loans, COL for the Fire Department and Delinquent Personal Property Tax remain the same. Holding Tanks are at \$4400. Motion to approve was made by Promersberger, seconded by Overman. All in favor, motion carried.

Overman reported on the action of the P&RC which they recommend to the Board. They denied the CSM for Robert Vokes but if the road issue can be solved, the Zoning Administrator can approve, approved the CSM for Richard Burnton and the Addendum #3 for Back-O-Beyond Condo. Motion to approve the recommendations was made by Overman, seconded by Promersberger. All in favor, motion carried.

The payroll vouchers # 15271 through 15281 in the amount of \$3,715.43 were presented for payment. Motion to approve was made by Promersberger, seconded by Overman, all in favor, motion carried. General vouchers #15223 through 15270 in the amount of \$25,552.79 were presented for payment. Motion to approve was made by Imse, seconded by Promersberger. All in favor, motion carried.

Some members of the Town of Spider Lake attended a meeting at the Town of Namekagon regarding ATV's on Town roads. The Town of Namekagon is not in favor of any Town Roads being open for ATV use. The Town of Spider Lake allows a few to make connecting routes north of the Town. Harry Wirth talked regarding the importance of limiting ATV routes in the Town of Spider Lake.

Imse reported on the insurance renewal of policies and information required for the Insurance Company.

Brandt reported that most of the white goods have been picked up and the recycling grant application has been filed. The 15th of October ends the summer hours for the Solid Waste/Recycling site.

Krause reported that the new snowplows have been received and the Board needs to set a meeting for Union Negotiations.

Promersberger reported that the Fire Department account has \$5,436, with \$20,533.55 total assets. She has received a bid for the roof of the Town Hall and there are dead trees that need to be cut.

Ray Harris talked regarding lake buoys. Spider Lake has 19 to 20 buoys. This year they paid \$200. to have them removed. The Association cannot place buoys without a town agreement, the Board will contact the Town Attorney regarding the Town's involvement in placing and removing the buoys.

Nathan from Ghost Lake Lodge requests the speed limit for Ghost Lake be 10 mph. Krause told him to get a petition with signatures of property owners on the lake and bring it back to the Town Board.

Krause stated the Road Committee meet at Preston Road regarding the berms. The Tow will try to move the road over south west just on the right-of-way.

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The Board of Appeals had an application for a variance that was withdrawn after all the paper work had been sent out. The Boards feeling was to pay Imse expenses and _ the time he would have gotten for a meeting.

Prudence Ross wanted it on the record that she requests putting enforcement of the boating ordinance in the budget and that \$2,000. is not enough.

Overman stated that the hearing on the Sawyer County Amendments will be held and the Town is supposed to send in their approval or not approve the proposed amendments. Boss and Baumann to let Guyer know so she can return the form to Sawyer County.

Guyer reported on the upcoming election November 11th, final town population of 421, Union Negotiation meeting to be Oct. 19th at 7:00 P.M., Budget work session to be Oct. 24, 2006 and the Board of Review to be held October 30 from 6-8 P.M.

Motion to adjourn was made by Promersberger, seconded by Brandt. All I favor, motion carried.
