PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED 2009 BUDGET 11/19/08 6:30 PM

The Town of Spider Lake Public hearing on the proposed 2009 budget was called to order on November 19, 2008 by Chairman Krause. Elected officials present were Meyer, Brandt, Krause, Promersberger, McGuiness, Treasurer Overman and Clerk Guyer and 23 electors of the town.

The proposed budget was read by the Chairman. Discussion was held regarding the petition that was presented to the Board regarding a yellow strip up the center of Upper A Road which was not included in the Budget. The estimate for the 12 miles was \$12,000.00. The Town has approximately 50 miles of paved roads and the Board felt that if any of the roads were done, the taxpayers would want them all done. John Chandler stated that he thought there was a small highway improvement program grant to be used for safety issues that could be applied for. Sue Gorski suggested that the residents work with the Town Board to write a grant for this. Other items on the budget were discussed and explained.

The Total Budgeted Disbursements are \$631,818.00, Total Budgeted Receipts are \$337,331.00 with a proposed surplus December 31, 2008 of \$60,909.00 plus \$29,144.00 which is allocated to the Town Hall Carpet, Roads, Fire Department and Holding Tanks. The proposed levy for 2009 is \$233,578.00 which is the amount set by the State of Wisconsin as being the Town's maximum 2% Levy limit.

Motion to adjourn the Public Hearing was made by Promersberger, seconded by Meyer, all in favor, motion carried.
