ROAD COMMITTEE MEETING 12/15/2006 8:00AM**

Road Committee Meeting was held on the end of South Road. Purpose of the meeting was to look at the private road at the location of the new construction. This is in response to the private home owner at the end of the private road, concern for her safety.

Gene Krause, George Brandt and Kathy Overman (Kathy arrived a little after 8) also in attendance Marion Promersberger, private home owner at the end of the road.

The committee walked from the beginning of the road change to the end of the road change, took pictures and discussed some of the problem and discussed some of the recommendations we will bring to the attention of the owner/engineer/lawyer. Gene will call and discuss this with them.

Krause marked the road as to where changes should be considered and that the ground is not yet frozen so it could be done yet this fall. The need to cut the sharp corner that appears to be the most dangerous segment of the road for the parties that live beyond the new construction was the consensus of the committee because of the safety concerns, especially in winter.

One scenario we discussed was if the corner became icy, any slip would put that person over the edge of a very steep drop off.
