



TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING 6/12/02

The regular Monthly Town of Spider Lake Board of Supervisors meeting was called to order on June 12, 2002 by Chairman Krause. Present was Krause, Supervisors Brandt and Overman. Also present was Clerk Guyer, Zoning Administrator Boss and Treasurer Janet Brandt. Absent was Supervisors Promersberger and Dempsey.

The following minutes were reviewed by the Board:

Motion to approve the minutes was made by Overman, 2nd. by G. Brandt. All in favor, Motion Carried.

The Treasurers report was given and made part of the minutes. Balance on Hand 5/31/02 \$76,475.16. Balances on loans, Capitol Out Lay for the Fire Department and Holding tanks remain the same. Delinquent Personal Property Tax is Teal Wing in the amount of \$8,610.12 plus interest and penalty. Motion to approve the treasurers report was made by G. Brandt, 2nd. by Overman. All in Favor, Motion carried.

Payroll vouchers #12513-12530 in the amount of \$6,947.38 were presented for payment. Motion to approve was made by Overman, 2nd. by G. Brandt. All in favor, Motion carried.

General Vouchers #12531-12560 in the amount of \$22,848.02 were presented for payment. Motion to approve was made by Overman, 2nd. by G. Brandt. All in favor, Motion carried.

Krause explained a moratorium on Zoning Changes was put on until the Comprehensive Land Use Plan was completed. A Hearing on proposed Zoning amendment to be held 7-8-02 at 6:30 P.M. Motion to extend the Moratorium until 7/10/02 was made by G. Brandt, 2nd. by Overman. All in Favor, Motion carried.

The clerk was directed to write a letter to the County Forester to remove all tress within 20' of the center line for the 2nd. two miles of Rock Lake Fire Lane to get enough material to make a road.

Mark Franberg was present at the meeting and is logging on Rock Lake Fire Lane. He stated he pushed the trees back and did the first two miles of the road and the second two miles need to be done. He stated he had \$2,050. into the work on the road. Motion was made by G. Brandt, seconded by Overman to pay Franberg for the work he has done. All in Favor, Motion carried.

The Clerk reported on the County letter regarding the Town appointing a Dog Lister. Motion was made by Krause to table for further consideration, second by Overman. All in Favor, Motion Carried.

Removal of Dick-Sy Road from the Snowmobile Ordinance was discussed. Brandt reported that the State was out to look at a trail off the road but stated it would need a retaining wall. The cost would be approximately \$100,000. The Town could use the Sheriff's Department on a part time bases for enforcement. Wheel Inn

stated the unofficial trail by their business could be used as a trail to get down to Twin Lake and that could be taken to get to Dick-Sy Manor. Town to get a letter from Ed Bockmann that he would be willing to give an easement that that trail could be used as a snowmobile trail. G. Brandt moved to table the issue until they could talk to Marty at Dick-Sy Manor and Ed Bochmann at Wheel Inn and people effected by closing of Dick-Sy road until the next Board Meeting July 10, 2002. seconded by Overman. All in Favor, Motion Carried.

A meting will be held on June 19, 2002 with the Town Assessor, Town Board and Ross or a representative of Ross' Teal Lake Lodge. Meeting to be at 5:00 P.M. at the Town Hall..

Clerk to write a letter to the Spider Lake Chain of Lakes in support of a DNR grant on water quality they are applying for.

G. Brandt reported that one of the gates are bent at the solid waste site. The Solid Waste site will be collecting appliances, white goods, tires and batteries all during the month of June.

Overman stated the pavilion is started. they will be having a work day on Saturday, June 15th. Anyone willing to help will be appreciated. The Pavilion is insured. The plug in at the front of the Town Hall is out. A new vacuum is need in for the Town Hall. The Fire Dept. received a check from the hospital for \$1800. to apply toward a defibrillator. She stated that at the Fire Department meeting/training 6/6/02 a new grant from the DNR will be applied for. Six categories can be picked from, application date 7/1/02. A data base for mailing labels for the Town has been created and will be used by the Fire Department. Fire Department Savings account balance \$7363.70 and Checking Account \$856.88 for a Total of \$8,220.58

Motion was made by Dempsey, seconded by Promersberger to approve the Class A and B Beer and Liquor Licenses ad advertised and the Spider Lake Vol. Fire Department Picnic License for July 7, 2002. All in Favor, Motion Carried.

Krause stated the road workers are putting up new signs and removing some signs. They have done some reconstruction on Telemark road. The Road crew did the excavating for the Fire Dept. pavilion.

Clerk was authorized to pay Dragonfly, Schneiders and Fanberg bills.

Motion to adjourn was made by Overman, 2nd. by G. Brandt. All in favor, Motion carried.
